## **MODE OF SELECTION**

- i Written test The screening shall be made through objective type of test (MCQs) for 50 marks in the respective subject for 1 hour. Candidates scoring 50% or above (Gen) and 45% or above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) will be considered for Skill test.
- ii Skill test For the candidates short-listed on the basis of written test.

The Selected candidates will be empanelled and will be operated as per the arrival of the vacancies in AEC Schools/Jr. Colleges at Mumbai.

- 3. Candidates must submit separate applications for each post, if applying for more than one post.
- 4. Candidates whose examination results are awaited may also apply. They will be considered subject to submitting proof of acquiring desired qualifications at the time of Skill test
- 5. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the written test and skill test for the candidates.
- 6. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
