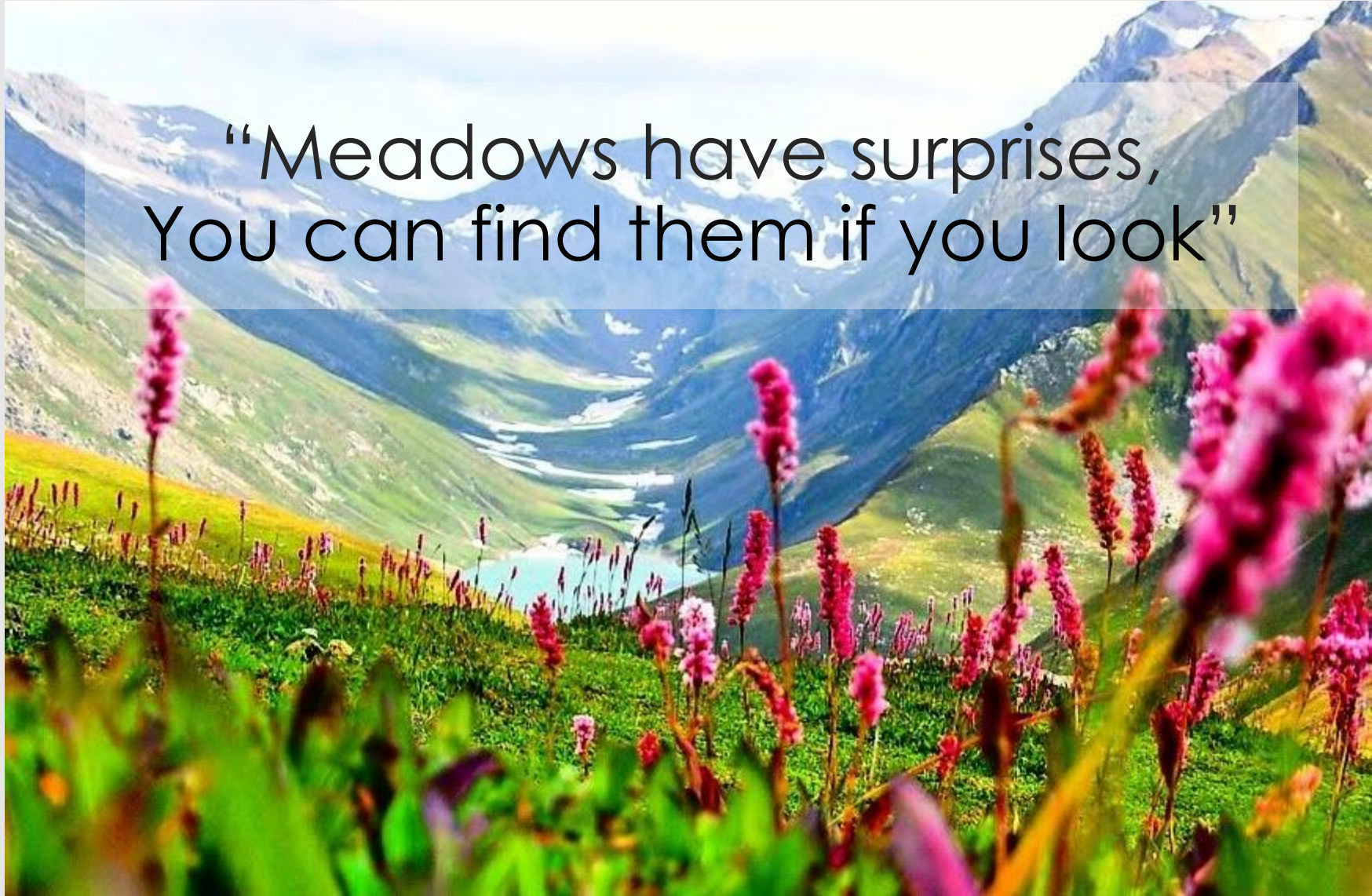

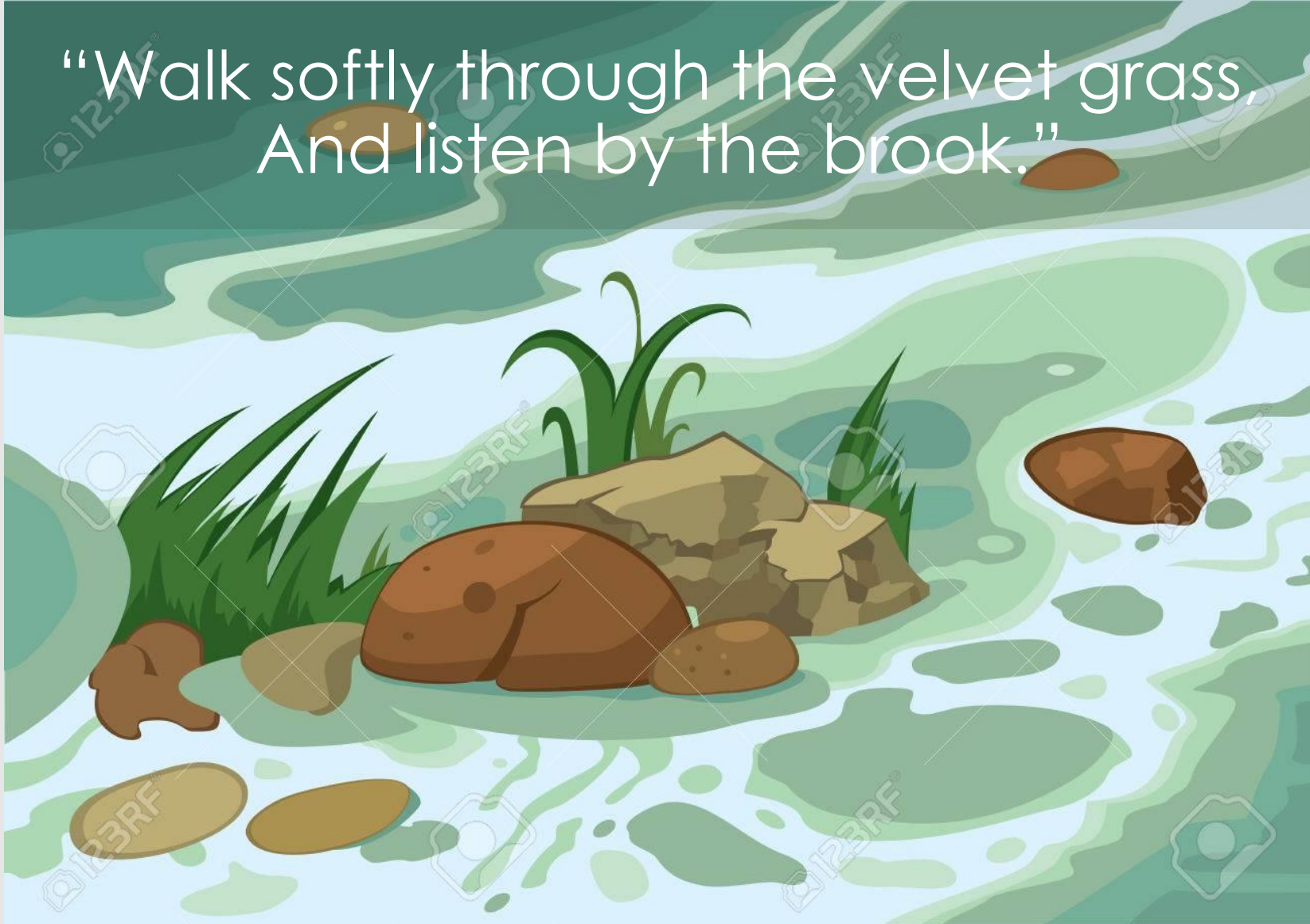

You can find them if you look”



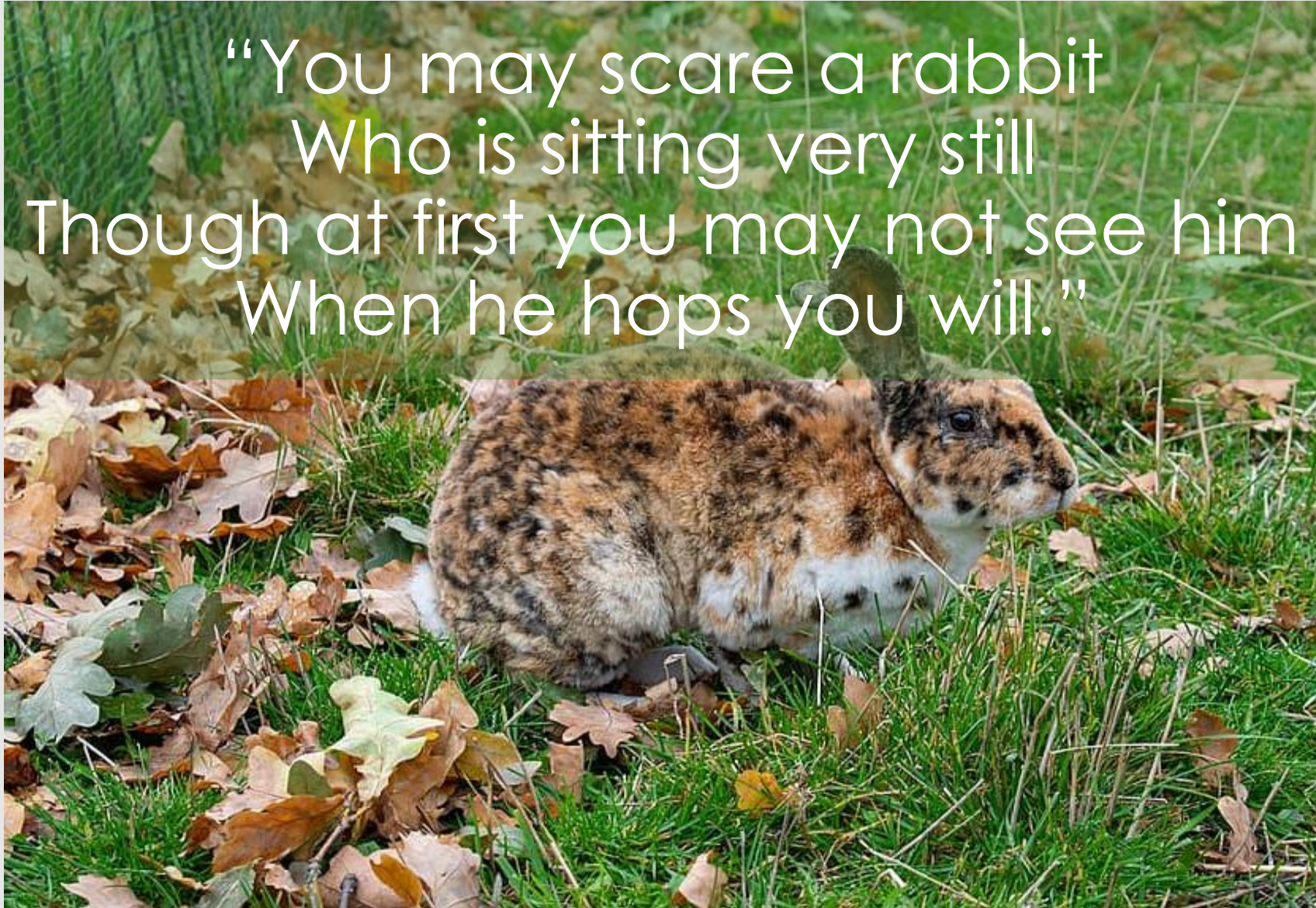
“Walk softly through the velvet grass,
