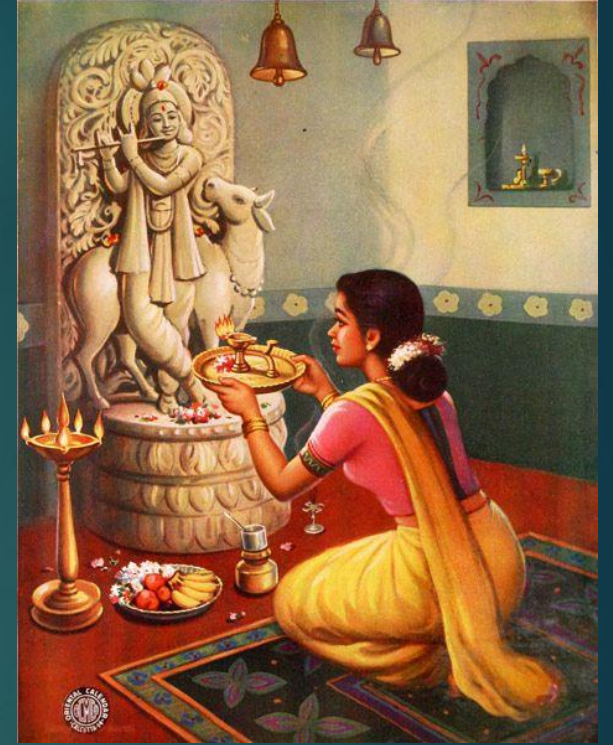
1. The beginning of Bhakti

- It is generally understood as a person's devotion to his or her chosen deity.
- Anybody, whether rich or poor, belonging to the so-called high caste or low caste, man or woman could follow the path of Bhakti.
- The main deities included Shiva, Vishnu and Durga.
- Worship of deities became a central feature of later Hinduism.
- The idea of Bhakti is present in the Bhagavad Gita, a sacred book of the Hindus.
- According to Bhakti, if a devotee worships the chosen deity with a pure heart, the deity will appear in the form in which he or she may desire.
- Artists made beautiful images of deities.



Meaning of Bhakti

- ✚ Comes from a Sanskrit term bhaj.
- ✚ This suggests a very intimate relationship between – the devotee and the deity.
- ✚ Deities were placed in special homes called temples.
- ✚ The word Hindu was derived from river Indus.

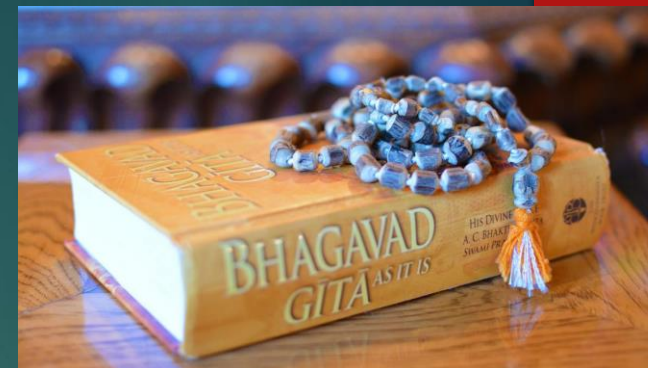
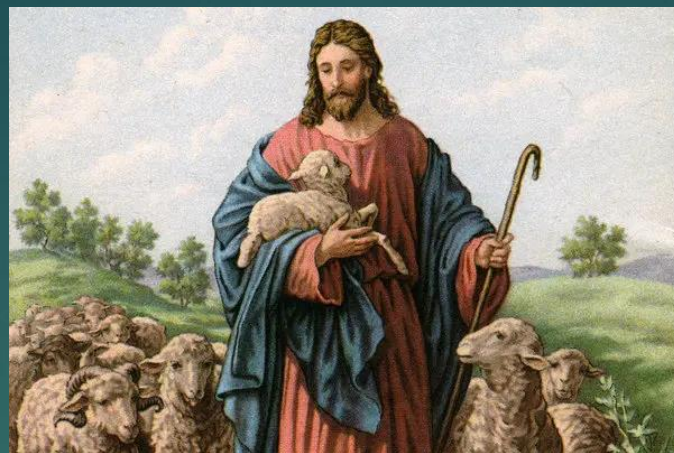
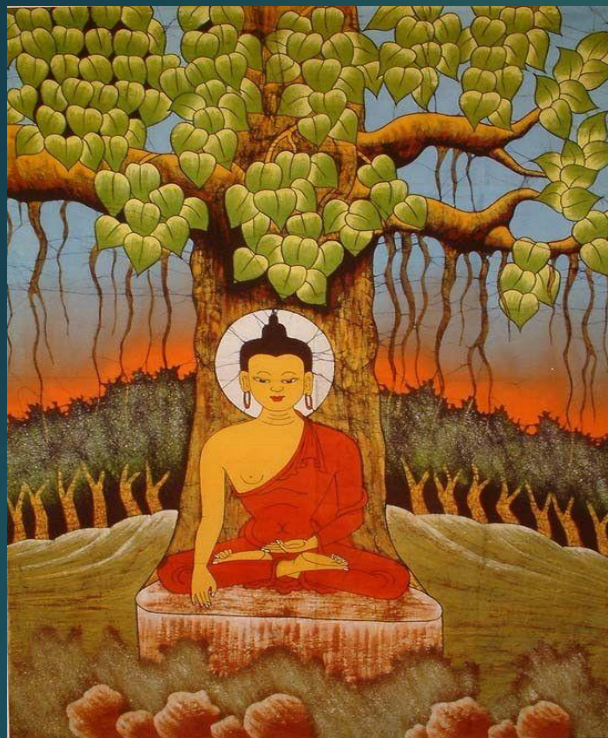


2. Christianity
