




Have you identified these instruments in your geometry box.




The Ruler (Straight Edge)



- A Ruler ideally has no markings on it.
- However the ruler in your instruments box is graduated into centimeters along one edge and inches along the other edge



USES: To draw line segments To measure lengths.



The Compasses

A pair- a ponter on one end and a pencil on the other USES:

To mark of equal lengths (but not to measure them)


To draw arcs and circles.






The Divider: A pair of pointers

▶ USES: To compare lengths.






The Protractor

A semi circular device graduated into 180 degree parts. The measure starts from 0^{0} on the right hand side and ends with 180^{0} on the left hand side and vice-versa.

USES: To draw and measure angles.






Set – Squares:

► Two triangular pieces-one of them has 45°, 45°, 90° angles at the vertices and other has 30°, 60°, 90° angles at the vertices.

▶ USES: To draw perpendicular and parallel lines.
