(A) EDUCATIONAL AND OTHER QUALIFICATIONS FOR TRAINED(TGT) POST GRADUATE TEACHER

Essential:

(i) Four years Integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate OR
Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subjects/combination of subjects and in aggregate.

(ii) B.Ed or Equivalent degree from recognized university.

(iii) Pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

Desirable : Knowledge of Computer Applications.

D	Information
i.	Candidates whose examinations results are awaited may also apply. They will be considered, if selected, subject to submitting proof of acquiring desired qualifications at the time of interview.

ii.	The screening shall be made through objective (multiple choice questions) type examination pattern of 50 marks. Candidates scoring 50% and above (Gen) and 45% and above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) in their written test will be eligible for short listing for personal interview. The personal interview will carry 50 marks. Candidates scoring 50% or above (Gen) and 45% or above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) will be considered for preparation of the final merit list.
iii.	Teaching experience in an English Medium School/College and Knowledge of Computer operations. Use of modern educational technology are desirable.

Note : Pass in central teacher eligibility test (CTET), conducted by CBSE in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE is essential for TGT. In the absence of CTET qualified candidates, candidates without CTET qualified may be considered.
