The skill test will be conducted to broadly evaluate the competency of the candidate in the following aspects:

- 1. Subject knowledge and teaching ability
- 2. Communication skills
- 3. Confidence and poise

The candidate shall be evaluated on various aspects such as (among others):

- a) Accuracy
- b) Logical thinking
- c) Use of examples/illustrations
- d) Time management
- e) Language proficiency
- f) Creativity, etc.
