

School Profile



SCHOOL-STRENGTH

The school runs classes from Balavatika-1 to X, having two sections in each class with the exception of Class One having a single section and Classes 3 & 5 with three sections each. The total strength of students studying for the current academic year, 2023-24 stands at 955 including 144 RTE and 99 Non-DAE students.



SCHOOL-FACULTY

As for the faculty, there are 13 permanent TGTs and 4 Contract TGTs, 10 permanent PRTs and 6 Contract PRTs and 3 permanent Prep teachers, 2 office staff and 4 Work Assistants. The team is led by Principal, Vice-principal and Headmaster.




NCC- National Cadet Corps

November, 2023.
















K) FELICITATION OF MR. MADHAV REDDY (ALUMNUS) MIKE


THE LMC AND THE SAC MEETINGS:


