PHRASE

The **sentence**, as we know, is a group of words that make complete sense.

Let us see the various steps that lead to a place.

The smallest part of the written English language is the letter -

A, B, C and so on.

A group of letters forms a word – great, happy, table and so on.

Phrase:

A phrase is a group of words that either has no verb or has a non-finite verb and does not make complete sense.

For example: a) Two pretty babies.

- B) To sail in the ocean.
- C) Ducks swimming in the pond.

In the above examples, you can see that whether the group of words is long or short, none of them contains a finite verb and none of them makes complete sense. Such groups of words are known as **phrases.**
