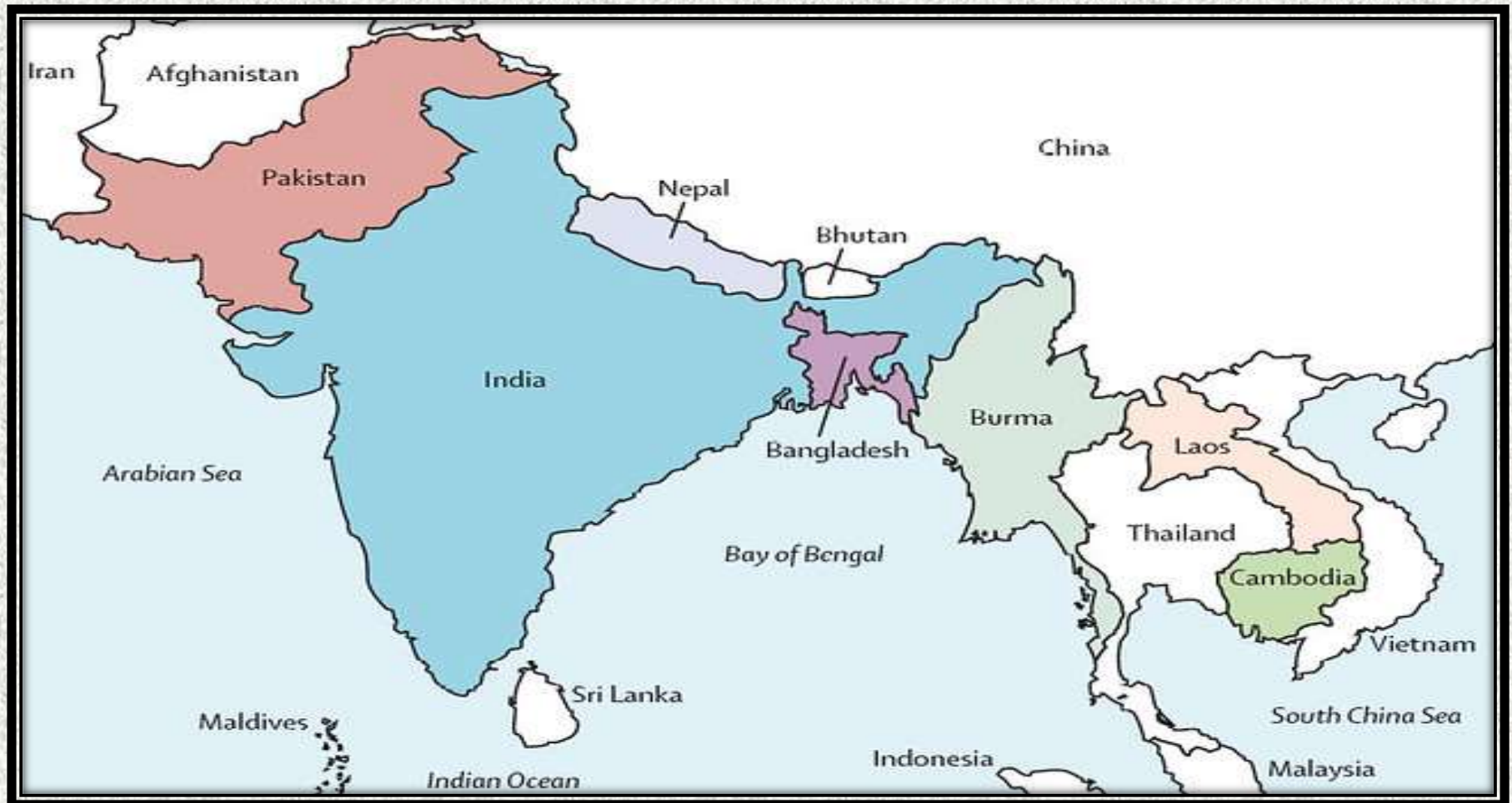

# POLITICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS

- The states are further divided into districts.
- The Indian Government works at three different levels.

There are **28 states** and **9 Union territories** in the country. Union Territories are administered by the President

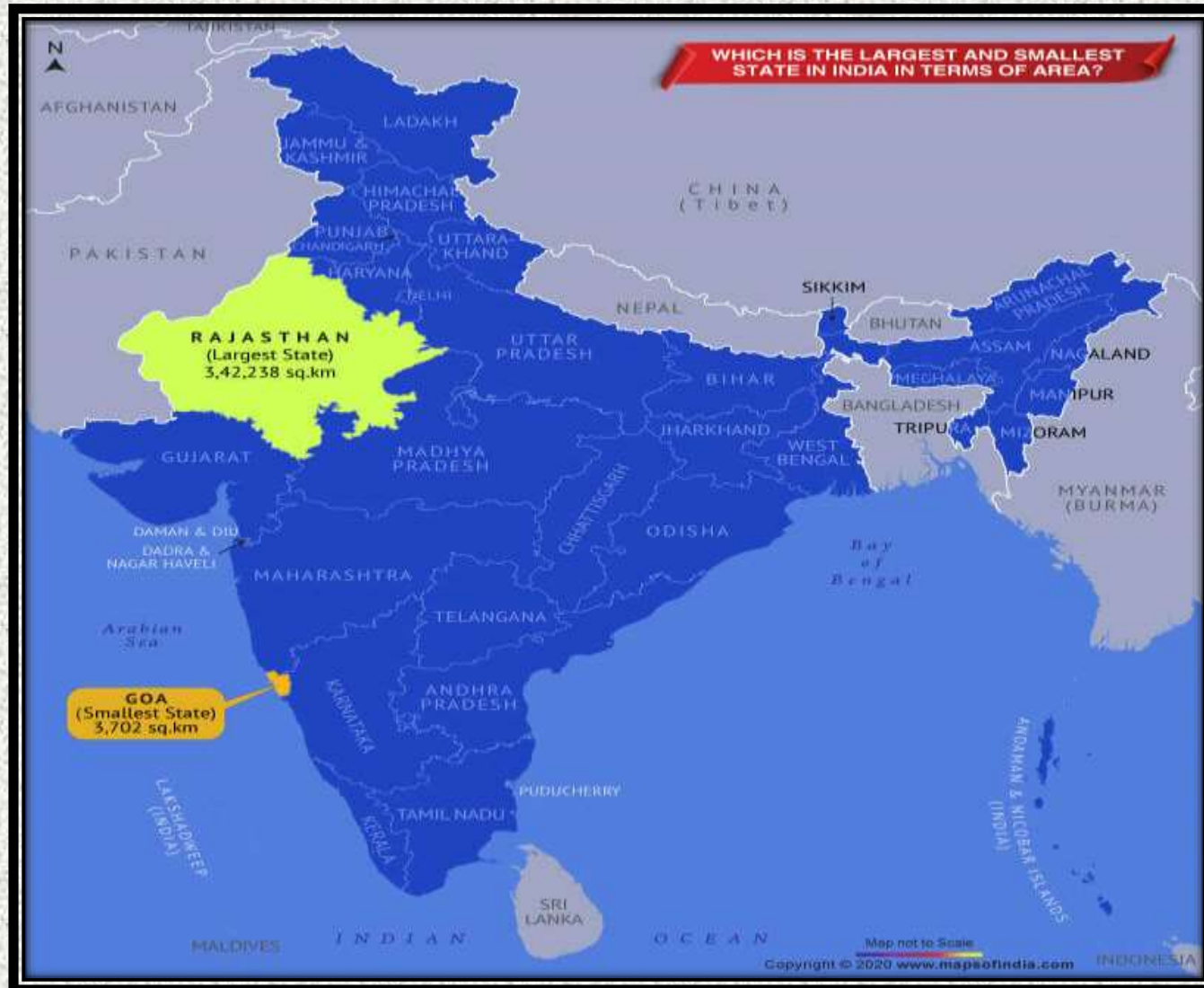


Union Territories are: Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu, National Capital Territory of Delhi, Jammu and Kashmir, Lakshadweep, Ladakh and Puducherry.
