## Introduction

• Maria Yuryevna Sharapova, born 19 April 1987, is a Russian retired professional tennis player. Although she played under the banner of Russia with the Women's Tennis Association (WTA), she has lived in and been a United States permanent resident since 1994. Sharapova competed on the WTA tour from 2001 to 2020 and had been ranked world No. 1 in singles by the WTA on five separate occasions. She is one of ten women, and the only Russian, to hold the career Grand Slam. She is also an Olympic medalist. Sharapova achieved a rare level of longevity in tennis, with several tennis pundits and former players calling Sharapova one of tennis' best competitors. Sharapova became the world No. 1 for the first time on 22 August 2005, at the age of 18, becoming the first Russian female tennis player to top the singles rankings. She won five Grand Slam titles.
