

  \*According to recent reports, more than a
  quarter of the population living in rural areas of
  India is below the poverty line.
- Out of the total population living in the rural parts of India, 25.7% is living below the poverty line.
- In the urban areas, the situation is a bit better with 13.7% of the population living below the poverty line.

## **ESTIMATES OF POVERTY IN INDIA**

Consumption Versus Income Level: Poverty line estimation in India is based on the consumption expenditure.

Variation in Income: Income of self-employed people, daily wage laborers etc. is highly variable both temporally and spatially while consumption pattern are comparatively much stable.
