Sub: Rescheduling of dates for the Academic Session 2020-21 - reg.

This is in continuation of AEES Order No. AEES/CAO/2020/5457 dated 20/03/2020.

- 2. In view of the present situation, it is now decided that the schools will continue to remain closed for summer vacation for students beyond 31-03-2020 till 31-05-2020. The schools will reopen on 01-06-2020 after the vacation.
- 3. Decisions related to postponed school examination and declaration of results for Classes I to IX and Class XI; and the dates for fee collection will be informed by AEES at an appropriate time. AEES website may be visited for further updates in this regard.
- 4. In order to compensate the loss of classroom teaching for students, holidays and other vacations would be curtailed/re-scheduled during the Academic Year 2020-21. There could be some inconvenience owing to this re-scheduling of vacations, and any further alterations of schedule if the situation demands. Parents may be advised not to plan any travel in advance, presuming any dates for mid-term break and winter break.
- 5. Due to present lockdown, the schools will be closed for all the staff members of AEC Schools/Junior Colleges and the Staff of Central Office, AEES till 14/04/2020. They are all advised to attend their regular duties from 15/04/2020. However, the local authorities/Central Office authorities can decide to ask any staff member to attend school/office for any exigency of work. Urgent summons for work shall be commensurate with health safety norms as prescribed by the authorities. All the Teaching, Non-Teaching staff of Schools and Central Office including all Principals should be available on Mobile/ WhatsApp/ Telephone and other means of communication at all times and should be available in Headquarters.
- 6. Summer vacation for all vacation staff including teachers will be declared by AEES at an appropriate time and staff members may be advised to visit the AEES website from time to time. They may also be advised not to plan any travel in advance. AEES will launch a Distance Education Programme, in which all teachers and students are required to participate. Updates on this count will be issued shortly.
- 7. Heads of AEC Schools/Junior colleges are requested to ensure that the above information is disseminated to all the staff members, students and their parents.
