This was partly because of the hostility that Aurangzeb's intolerance and taxation inspired in the population,

The empire had become so large it was too difficult to govern. The Muslim Governer of Hyderabad in southern India rebelled and established a separate state;

He reintroduced religious toleration. The Hindu kingdoms also fought back, often supported by the French and the British, who used them to tighten their grip on the sub-continent.

The establishment of a Hindu Maratha Empire in southern India cut off the Mughal state to the south.
