1. Descriptive adjectives

These words show the kind of quality of a person or thing

my pen

our country

2. Possessive adjectives

These are words which show or hint at a sense of belonging

this book

these pens

that man

those trees

3. Demonstrative adjectives

These are the words which 'point out' at something or someone (like demonstrative pronouns)

Which umbrella is yours?

Whose pencil is this?

What book are you reading?

4. Interrogative adjectives

These are words which ask about the noun

fourchairs

all men

every boy

both houses

many flowers

enough money

5. Adjectives of quantity

These are words which describe quantity. It includes all the numerals.

- My father has bought a new car.
- Which sarge do you want?
- Here are some grapes.
- Every word of her story is false.
- That girl won the second prize.
- Neither boy has done his homework.
