ORDER

The competent authority in AEES has approved the revised ceiling of reimbursement of telephone bills/charges used for official purpose with regard to telephones installed at the residence of Senior Officers of Central Office, Head, Academic Unit and Principals/Vice-principals In charge of AEES. The ceiling for reimbursement of telephone expenditure on use of land line and/or Mobile connection and Broad Band connection for official purpose has been fixed in terms of Dept of Expenditure O.M. Nos. 7(14)/C&V/2006 dated 14.11.2006 and 10.04.2007 equating the Officers of AEES in accordance with their Grade Pay.

The ceiling amount for reimbursement of telephone expenditure in respect of each category of officer will be regulated as shown in the table given below:

- (1) The amount reimbursable is exclusive of all taxes, if any.
- (2) Sr. Officers of Central Office and Principals of AECS/JC who are in the Grade Pay of Rs.7600/- and above are required to subscribe to Broadband facility and in its absence, Rs.400/- shall be deducted/reduced from the ceiling amount, i.e. `1500-400 = `1100/- p.m.

2 -

The amount will be reimbursed within the prescribed ceiling for both landline and post paid mobile connection on submission of bill/receipt by the concerned officer.

There will not be any separate ceilings for landline and/or mobile/broad-band.

(1) Reimbursement shall be restricted to one landline and/or one mobile connection

only.

The guidelines stipulated by Department of Expenditure vide its OMs dated 14.11.2006

and 10.04.2007 will be made applicable towards reimbursement of residential telephone

bills (copies enclosed).

This order will come into force with effect from 01.01.2012.
